The Enfield Historical Society has three museums of Enfield history: The Old Town Hall Museum, 1294 Enfield Street, the Martha A. Parsons House, 1387 Enfield Street, and the one-room Wallop School, 250 Abbe Road. All three museums are open to the public free of charge. Our museums house collections of thousands of artifacts and documents from Enfield's past, all available to the public. The Old Town Hall and Martha Parsons House are open May through October and other times by appointment. The Wallop School is open one Sunday each month, June through September, and other times by appointment. 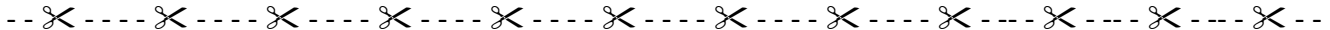
